

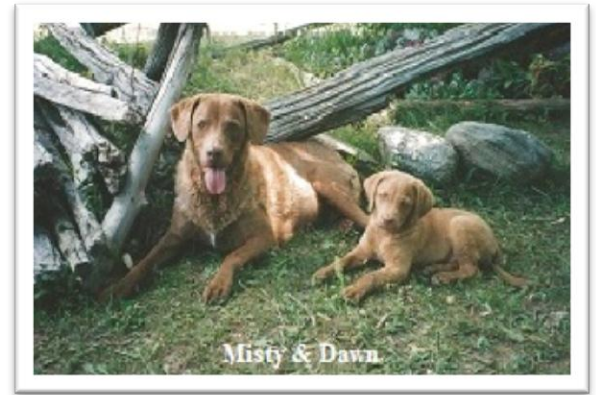
Dawn's Story
